

INCLUSION CRITERIA

Children scheduled for an outpatient bowel clean out in the Day Medicine department.

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- None.

MEASURES

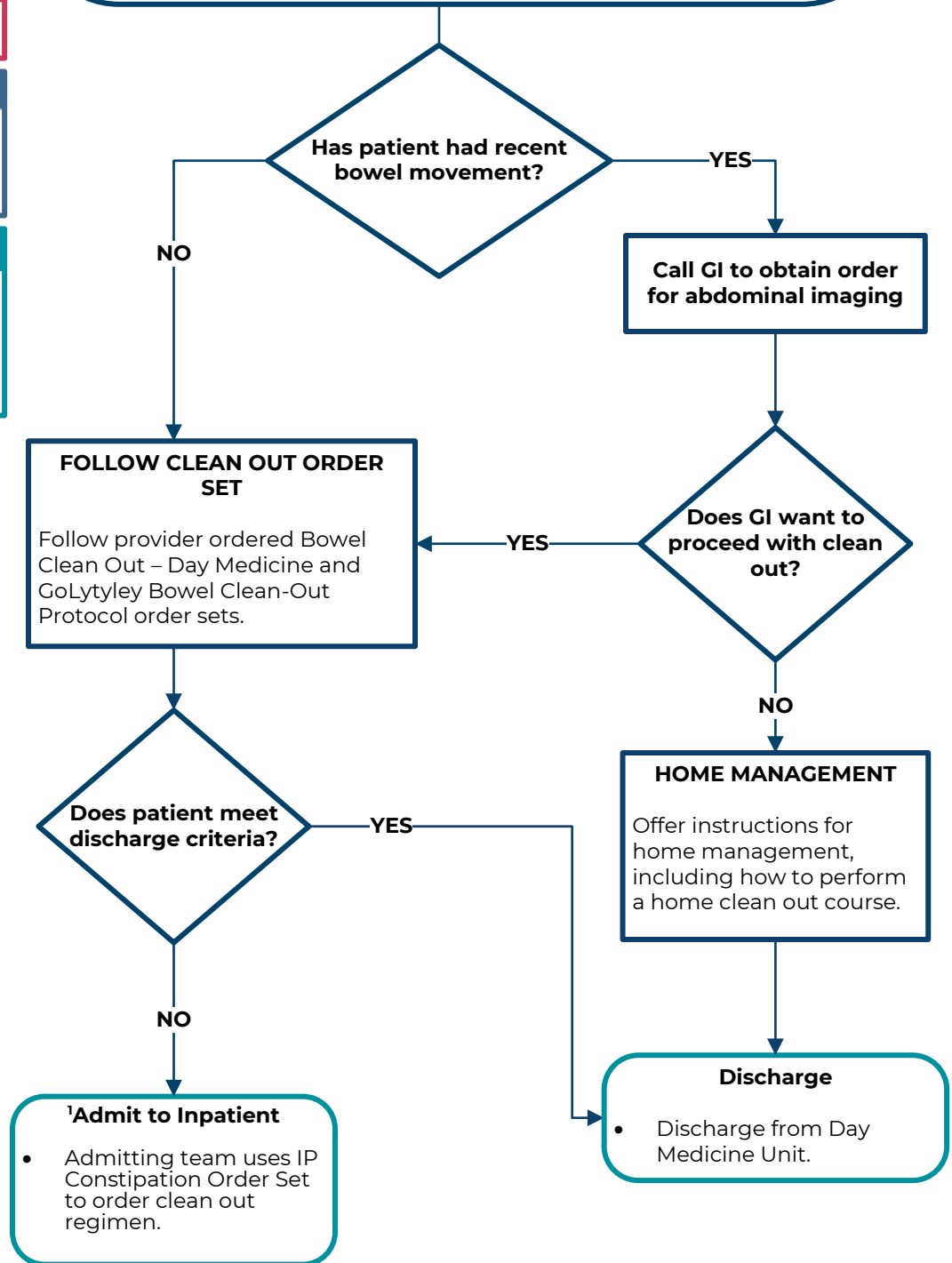
- Reduce number of in person cancellations

ADMISSION CRITERIA¹

- Patient unable to complete clean out in Day Medicine area.
- Continued abdominal distention and/or pain.

Initial Nursing Assessment

- Ask about any past or current constipation management.
- Are clean outs sufficient at home?
- Is the patient seen by outpatient GI provider already? Who/where?
- Obtain vital signs and complete physical assessment.
- **For needs or concerns, reach out to GI team.**
